## Club Rules Reminder to All Members

We have all been away from the rally field for a while now, so just a reminder from the committee regarding some of our rules on the rally field which seemed to have been forgotten over lockdown.

All the below are detailed in our rule book or code of conduct, which is issued to all members on joining and supports our application to hold our caravan & camping exemption certificate which enables us to hold our rallies.

A copy of our latest revisions of code of conduct and constitution rules are attached to this newsletter for your information.

- **Report to Rally Marshal** - On arrival at site all members and members visitors / guests must report to the rally marshal.
- **Waste Bins / skips** – Please note the waste bins the club provide at rallies are for your bagged waste only. If metal or other items are found disposal may be refused or the club gets additional charge costs.
- **Dogs** – All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times within the rally field, also please ensure your “doggy doo das” ..... poo to you & me .... is picked up.
- **Fire Buckets** – All units should have a fire bucket filled with water placed by their unit.
- **Speed limit** – A reminder that the site speed limit is 5 MPH / (or walking pace).
- **Spacing** – Please ensure when parking your unit, you have left sufficient space from the unit next to you (including awning etc). ‘Sufficient Space’ is defined as at least 6 meters / 20 feet apart, to ensure access of any emergency vehicles & for fire safety.

**Please note without marshals we are not allowed to let rallies go ahead.**

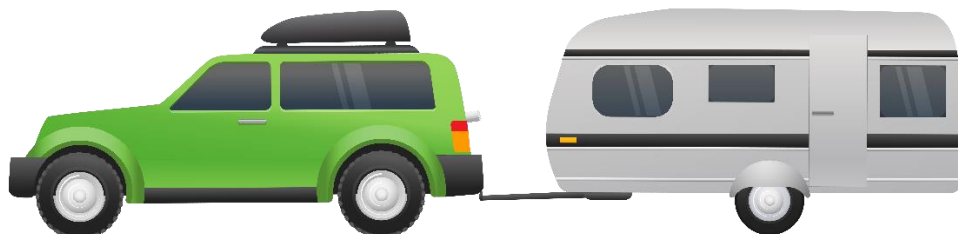

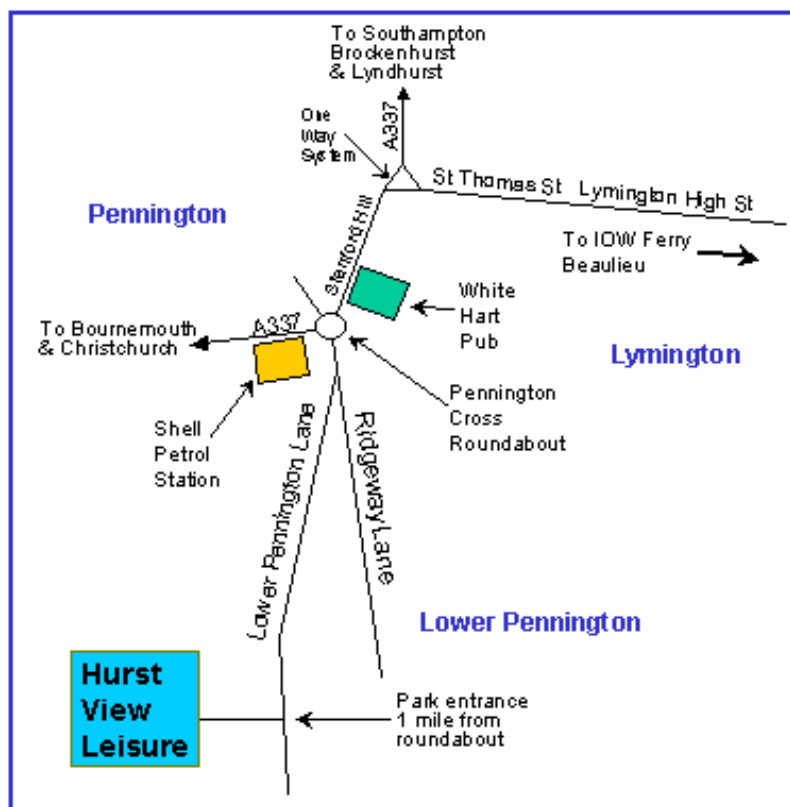

**Route Directions:** M27 at Junction 1 or 2, Follow the signs A35 to Lyndhurst. At Lyndhurst take the A337 Brockenhurst to Lymington Road. At Lymington Keeping on the A337 in Lymington, follow signs for Milford-on-Sea until you reach Pennington Cross roundabout. Take the first exit and then turn right into Lower Pennington Lane. Continue down the lane following SP Hurst View Campsite, look out for the NFCCA waymarkers.
